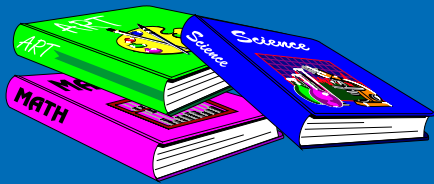

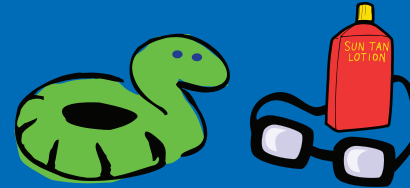

Fun Time Stations Children are placed in small groups based on the grade they are entering. During station time, we incorporate the PA State Learning Standards. The goals are to keep academic skills fresh over the summer, apply the knowledge the children have learned and prepare them for the next school year. Each camper has 40 minutes a week of instruction in these areas: Literacy, Art and Physical Education. Campers also spend time preparing for their Friday Showcase.
