

## **Conestoga Pines Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations**

### ***General Rules:***

- Everyone entering the pool groups must pay admission whether they are swimming or not.
- Proper swimming attire is necessary to enter the pool. No jeans or cutoffs are allowed.
- Swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- Showers must be turned off after use.
- Feet-first entry in the pool only. No diving.
- Children 6 years old and under must have an adult with them in the water to swim in the large pool.
- Children under 48 inches must pass a swim test administered by a lifeguard to swim in deep water, unless the child is with an adult.
- Small floats are permitted in the pool at the manager's discretion.
- Pushing, dunking, flipping, and rough play in the pool or on deck are forbidden.
- Anyone who is sick, contagious, or has an open wound cannot swim.
- Patrons must obey pool staff at all times.
- Running on sidewalk surrounding pool is not permitted.
- Swearing, arguing, and fighting will not be tolerated. Anyone engaging in this behavior will be given one verbal warning. If actions reoccur, they will be asked to leave.
- Smoking is not permitted within pool fence.
- Alcohol is not permitted on the premise.
- Glass containers are not permitted.
- Pets are not permitted on pool grounds.
- Lancaster Rec is not responsible for your personal belongings.

### ***Baby Pool Rules:***

- Baby pool is for children 5 years old and younger.
- Caregiver must be in pool and within arm's reach of child.
- Children who are not toilet training must wear swim diapers while in pool.

**Anyone not following these rules may lose pool privileges without refund.**
