



The Lancaster Recreation Commission (Lancaster Rec) is a 501(c)3 non-profit agency formed by a partnership agreement between the City of Lancaster, School District of Lancaster and Lancaster Township.

Our mission is to provide quality and affordable recreation and learning opportunities to Lancaster residents. We strive to improve the quality of life for every member of our community. Our philosophy is to get residents active and healthy by engaging in a range of recreational activities, events and programs.

Governed by an 11-member board that represents our partners, Lancaster Rec offers an extensive list of services. Programs include youth and adult instructional sports programs and leagues, senior centers, fitness and wellness classes, summer playground and day camps, full-day child care for infants through age five, before and after school care and community special events. Our target audience are the residents of the City of Lancaster and Lancaster Township, which serves more than 76,000 residents in primarily urban areas.

Operating since 1909, Lancaster Rec has provided neighborhood-based programs for all ages with an emphasis on affordable programs for children at schools, parks, playgrounds and other indoor and outdoor facilities.

Over the past 35 years, Church World Service (CWS) Lancaster has welcomed more than 7,000 new neighbors to peace and safety in South Central PA.

Our holistic programs ensure that new neighbors can not only access local services, but also celebrate our diversity, amplify local voices, and develop diverse leaders who will lead our county over the next 50 years.

Programs include initial resettlement services like finding a home and enrolling children in school; job orientation and upskilling opportunities; and innovative services that promote family wellness and long-term stability. Our Immigration Legal programs provide low-cost legal advice and representation to the broader immigrant community, including unaccompanied children.

When we welcome refugees to Lancaster, we live out a promise – that this is a country of opportunity, and that with desire and capacity, anyone can grow and become a leader

Lancaster, PA is home to refugees & other immigrants from across the globe. A city with a long history of welcome, the BBC recognized Lancaster as "America's Refugee Capital," in 2017, resettling "20 times more refugees per capita than the rest of the United States.

Omar Mohammed, former refugee and CWS Lancaster Case Manager, hosted our first refugee and immigrant soccer tournament in 2016, In that first year, more than 150 community members came out to watch just four teams compete. Over the next five years, the tournament grew to include 16 teams in its final year before COVID-19 ended the tournament.

CWS Lancaster and Lancaster Rec are proud to present this new opportunity to bring refugees and immigrants together in a World-Cup style soccer tournament kicking off Lancaster's Welcome Week in September 2023. Over the course of the 8-week series, Lancaster residents from around the world will join together in community building, leadership development, and trauma support -- all through soccer. As a global sport, soccer allows players to get to know new neighbors, hone their leadership skills, and find joy and peace in a new home.
